## No-Bake Gingerbread Houses

Turn some of those old cardboard boxes you have lying around into delectable works of art. [Aleene's True Snow](#) works just like cake and baking icing when applied with a piping bag. So, get to work creating your very own gingerbread house that will last all holiday season long and never go stale!

- Begin by removing all the tape from the boxes and carefully deconstructing them.
- Cut the second and last flap at the top of the box to create roof shape.
- Turn the boxes to the flat side with no markings.
- With a pencil and a ruler, create the gingerbread house doors and windows.
- Fill your icing/decorating bag with Aleene's snow and begin going over pencil designs. Add your own designs to fill any blank spaces. Let dry
- Once dry, put the box back together to create houses.
- With the craft knife, cut squares out of cardboard to create the top of the roof. Glue on the roof and enjoy.
